Criteria for Approval When Applicable

#### **Greater Than Minimal Risk Studies**

- The research plan makes adequate provision for monitoring the data collected to ensure the safety of the subjects
- The protocol is scientifically valid and employs research procedures which are consistent with sound research design

#### **Studies With Vulnerable Populations**

• Additional safeguards have been included in the study to protect the rights and welfare of the vulnerable population

### **Clinical Trials**

 Available non-clinical and clinical information is adequate to support the proposed clinical trial Criteria for Approval When Applicable

#### **Initial Review**

- The researcher has the resources necessary to protect subjects
- The research is acceptable in terms of local context, applicable law, and standards of professional research conduct and practice

#### Initial Review of Multi-Site Research Where PI is Overall PI

 The plan for communication among sites is adequate to protect subjects
