

 <b>INSTITUTIONAL REVIEW BOARD ADMINISTRATION</b>	<b>OIA-304 WORKSHEET: IRB Composition</b>		
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The purpose of this worksheet is to provide support for Office of IRB Administration (OIA) staff reviewing whether the IRB is appropriately composed. This worksheet, or equivalent, is to be used. It does not need to be completed or retained. Note: All IRB members are voting members. There are no "non-voting IRB members."

**1 Objective Composition** (Check if "Yes." All must be checked)

<input type="checkbox"/>	The IRB has at least five members, not counting alternate IRB members.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The IRB does not consist entirely of men or entirely of women.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The IRB does not consist entirely of members of one profession.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The IRB has at least one member whose primary concerns are in scientific areas.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The IRB has at least one member whose primary concerns are in non-scientific areas.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The IRB has at least one member who is unaffiliated with the institution and whose immediate family is unaffiliated with the institution.

**2 Subjective Composition** (Check if "Yes." All must be checked)

<input type="checkbox"/>	To the extent possible, the qualifications of alternate members are comparable to the primary member to be replaced.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The members have varying backgrounds to promote complete and adequate review of research activities commonly reviewed.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The IRB is sufficiently qualified through its experience; expertise; diversity in terms of race, gender, cultural backgrounds, and sensitivity to such issues as community attitudes to promote respect for its advice and counsel in safeguarding the rights and welfare of <u>human subjects</u> .
<input type="checkbox"/>	The IRB includes persons knowledgeable of institutional commitments and regulations, applicable law, and standards of professional conduct and practice and has the ability to ascertain the acceptability of proposed <u>research</u> in terms of these areas.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The IRB has the ability to ascertain the acceptability of proposed <u>research</u> in terms of institutional commitments and regulations, applicable law, and standards of professional conduct and practice.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The IRB possesses the professional competence necessary to review research activities.
<input type="checkbox"/>	If the IRB reviews <u>research</u> that involves a vulnerable category of subjects, the IRB should include one or more individuals who are knowledgeable about and experienced in working with those subjects.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The IRB has no members responsible for business development.
<input type="checkbox"/>	The IRB has no members that own equity in the institution.

**3 Additional Requirements** (Check if "Yes." All must be checked)

<input type="checkbox"/>	The IRB has an IRB chair.
<input type="checkbox"/>	There are sufficient alternate IRB members.
<input type="checkbox"/>	If the IRB reviews biomedical research, the IRB has a member who is a nurse. ("N/A" if the IRB does not review biomedical research)

**4 Composition of an IRB that Reviews Research Involving Prisoners** (Check if "Yes," If the IRB reviews research involving prisoners, all must be checked)

<input type="checkbox"/>	A majority of the board (exclusive of <u>prisoner</u> members) has no association with the prison(s) involved, apart from their membership on the board.
<input type="checkbox"/>	At least one voting member of the board is a <u>prisoner</u> , or a prisoner representative with appropriate background and experience to serve in that capacity, including a working knowledge of the population to be recruited, a reasonable familiarity with the operations of prisons or confinement facilities, and any other legally imposed restrictive conditions involved in the <u>research</u> . (The prisoner representative may be an alternate member who becomes a voting member when needed.)
