An impartial witness will be present during the entire consent discussion.					
For subjects who do not speak English, the witness is conversant in both English and the subject's or the LAR's language.					
3 Requirements for Signature					
The subject or the subject's LAR will sign and date the short form consent form.					
The witness will sign and date the short form consent form and the summary.					
The person obtaining consent will sign and date the summary.					
If a subject or the subject's LAR is unable to read: An impartial witness will be present during the entire consent discussion. The consent document witness signature line indicates that the witness was present for the entire consent discussion; the information in the consent document and any other information provided was accurately explained to, and apparently understood by, the subject or the subject's LAR; and that consent was freely given.
